



Death Penalty Holiday Card Action: Messages of Hope

Each year during the winter holidays, Amnesty International (AI) asks its members to send messages of encouragement to prisoners and human rights defenders around the world. This year, AIUSA's Program to Abolish the Death Penalty has organized a special "Death Penalty Holiday Card Action" to send words of support to murder victims' family members and to ensure that everyone on death row receives at least one message of hope this holiday season.

A simple greeting card can bring renewed hope to those who fear they've been forgotten by the world. Please let those on death row, their families, and the families of murder victims know that they are in your thoughts.

In this guide, you will find instructions on where to send cards and how to make sure they are delivered. This document is also available online at www.amnestyusa.org/abolish.

When sending cards to death row inmates:

- ✉ We encourage those of you in death penalty states to send cards to everyone on death row in your state (to the extent possible). If you have the capacity to do more, please consider sending cards to inmates in states with very large death row populations, such as Alabama, California, Florida, Ohio, Pennsylvania, or Texas.

We encourage those of you in non-death penalty states to adopt another state, especially one with a large death row, or to send cards to those on federal/military death row.

Starting on page five of this guide, you will find the mailing addresses for each state's death row, as well as websites that list the names of those on death row in a particular state (in some instances, you will need to conduct an "inmate locator search" by first and last name). In most cases, you will find this information on the Department of Corrections website for each state. You can also download *Death Row USA*, a quarterly report by the Criminal Justice Project of the NAACP Legal Defense and Educational Fund, Inc.: <http://www.deathpenaltyinfo.org/DRUSA%20Summer%202006.pdf>. This report contains the names of all those on death row in the United States as of July 1, 2006 (this report will be particularly useful if you have to conduct an inmate search by name).

You will need to include the appropriate prisoner ID number as part of the address for each card. That information generally is available on the Department of Corrections website for each state (in some states you will need to call the prison for this information). See below for more details.

✉ In most states, here's how to address mail to death row inmates:

First Line: Name of offender followed by his/her inmate number

Second line: Name of Institution

This is followed by the rest of institution's mailing address. Check below for more specific instructions, or check with the state's Department of Corrections.

- ✉ If you have questions about any individual death row inmates, please consult with the appropriate AIUSA State Death Penalty Abolition Coordinator (SDPAC) or state anti-death penalty coalition. Go to www.amnestyusa.org/abolish/sdpac/index.html to send an email to the SDPAC in a given state. Website addresses for state coalitions appear below.
- ✉ Send simple messages of goodwill, such as "We are thinking of you" or "Wishing you a season of hope and peace." Please do not discuss the inmate's case or your opinions on the death penalty.
- ✉ People on death row hold diverse religious beliefs. Please send non-religious greetings rather than messages that relate to Christmas or other specific religious holidays.
- ✉ Please do not use glue, stickers, glitter, or any other decorative elements with your cards or envelopes, as this is prohibited by most prisons.
- ✉ Please do not send anything other than the holiday card, as pictures, blank paper, extra stamps, etc. are prohibited by most prisons.
- ✉ One of AIUSA's SDPACs reports that some prisons do not accept mail that appears to be sent to every single prisoner (mass mailings). We suggest that you break up mass mailings into smaller bunches and drop some cards in the mailbox every day over the course of a week (or more). This seems to be an effective way to get around the rules.
- ✉ Please handwrite both the "To" and "From" addresses on each card, to give them a personal touch (and to avoid the appearance of sending a mass mailing). Some prisons also have rules against the use of labels on envelopes.
- ✉ If you are sending cards in a personal or individual capacity and do not feel comfortable providing your home address (or do not wish to initiate a correspondence with someone on death row), please feel free to list AIUSA as the return address (AIUSA; 600 Pennsylvania Ave. SE 5th Floor; Washington, DC 20003), or ask your state coalition if there is a PO Box address that you could use. Student groups may wish to use their general school address as the return address. You **MUST** provide a return address and include your name at the top, however, in order for your cards to be delivered.
- ✉ Cards may be sent until January 31, 2007.

- ✉ Send simple messages of goodwill, such as "We are thinking of you" or "Wishing you a peaceful season." Please do not discuss your opinions on the death penalty.
- ✉ Please send non-religious greetings rather than messages that relate to Christmas or other specific religious holidays.

- You may not put stickers on the envelope or letter, no thick cards that have two layers bonded together or ones with "pop ups," etc. (where something could be hidden between the two layers). No more than five pieces of non-letter material (ie. news clippings, essays, poems, etc.), no loose stamps or SASE, no items larger than 8 x 10 (give or take a few inches - the most common size large brown envelope).
- Address must include inmate number (without the cell number they will get it but it could take quite a while; without the inmate number, it will be returned) include a return address, no packages, no money, no photos of any inmate including the inmate to whom you are sending the letter.
