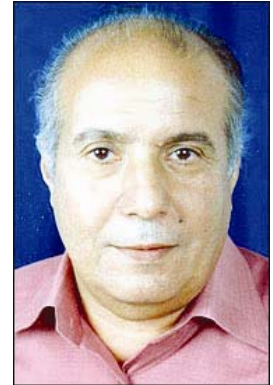

Your Excellency:

We wish to express our concern that democracy advocate Fathi el-Jahmi continues to be detained for seeking peaceful political reforms in Libya. He was arrested in 2002 after calling for free speech and reforms during a conference in Tripoli. Authorities released him in March 2004 but arrested him again weeks later after he repeated his call for democracy during a media interview.

The 66-year-old former provincial governor Fathi el-Jahmi suffers from diabetes, high blood pressure and coronary artery disease. There are serious concerns about whether he is receiving adequate medical care to treat his deteriorating state of health.

Amnesty International considers Fathi el-Jahmi to be a prisoner of conscience, who has been detained solely for the peaceful expression of his political views. We respectfully urge you to bring about his immediate and unconditional release and the release of all others in Libya who have been jailed solely for exercising their right to freedom of expression. We thank you for your assistance.
