



# “Tear it Down!” Guantanamo Video Contest

Want to see Guantanamo Bay **shut down** for good?

Want to see America become an International leader in **protecting human rights**?

Then work with your Amnesty Group to submit a video that expresses **YOUR** view on Guantanamo! **EVERY** video will be on our YouTube channel and will be **shown across the country** with an exhibit of a replica Guantanamo Cell. The **top 5** will be shown on the Amnesty USA website and will be shown at the Amnesty USA ‘08 National Conference!



**Content:** Your local or student group should submit a 30 second to 2 minute long video directed at the US Government expressing your Groups’ views on Guantanamo. There are no constraints on how you accomplish this, so be creative! Just remember you should stick to relevant issues like:

- Torture, Civil Liberties violations, The "War on Terror," Extraordinary Rendition, etc

**Tone:** Your video can be funny, thoughtful, factual, emotional, or whatever you want it to be. You can address this to President Bush, Vice President Cheney, or your Congress member: so long as it’s appropriate and about Guantanamo we encourage you to express yourself however you see fit!

**Deadline:** To be in the top 5 for the contest, videos must be submitted by Friday, March 21. However, we will accept submissions until the end of March, and all appropriate submissions will be featured on the YouTube website and will appear on the tour with the Guantanamo cell.

**How to Enter:** Once you’ve made your video, go to [www.youtube.com/group/AmnestyContest](http://www.youtube.com/group/AmnestyContest) to join our group. After you’ve joined the group click on the link that says **Add a Video**. From there follow the YouTube instruction on how to upload a video.
