Dear Senior General Than Shwe:

We were very pleased that prisoner of conscience and Nobel Peace Prize laureate **Daw Aung San Suu Kyi** was released from house arrest on November 13, 2010. We urge the release of all other prisoners of conscience in Myanmar.

The detention of Myanmar's estimated 2,200 political prisoners - many of whom are considered to be prisoners of conscience - is of profound concern to the international community. The continued detention of people like student leaders Htay Kywe, Mie Mie, and Zaw Htet Ko Ko, labor activist Su Su Nway, Buddhist monk U Gambira, and comedian and actor Zarganar violates the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which you are obligated to uphold as a member of the United Nations. We urge you to bring about the immediate and unconditional release of these, and all other prisoners of conscience in Myanmar. Thank you.
