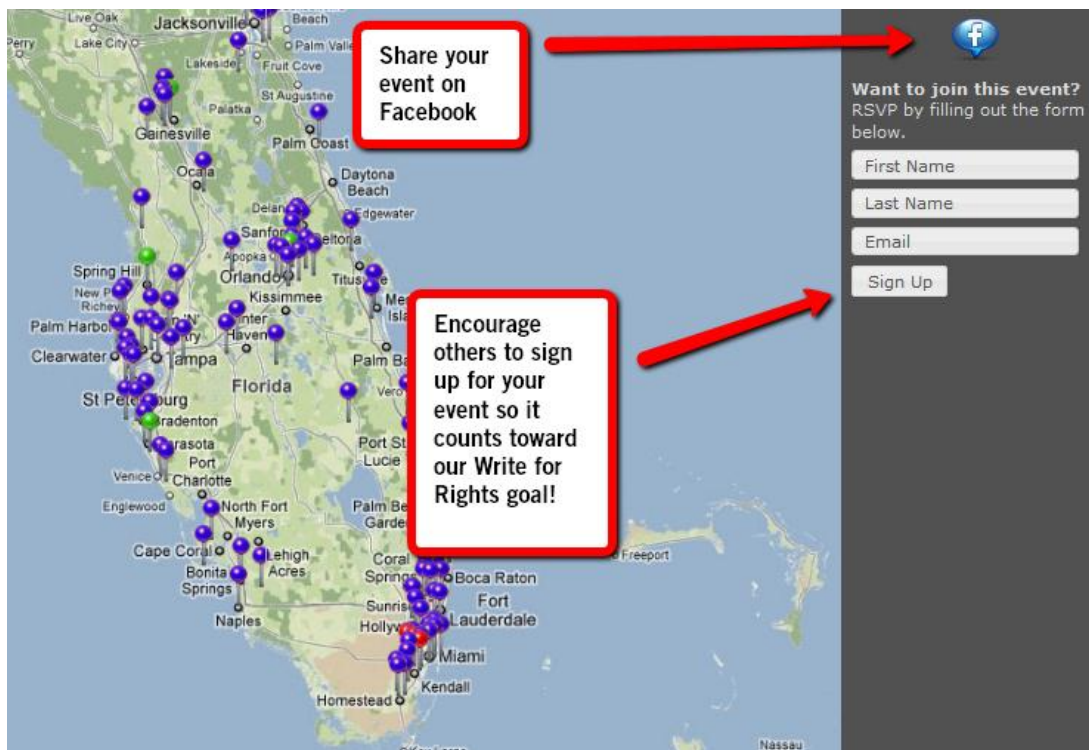
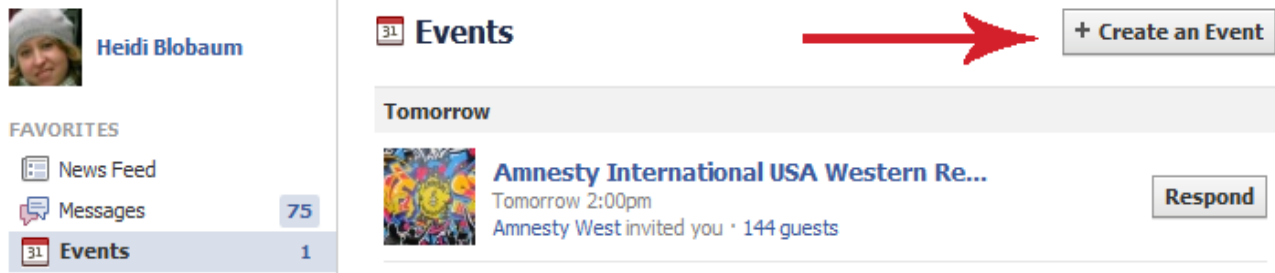


So you're planning a Write for Rights event that's open to the public? Here are some tips on how to use social media to spread the word about your event:

- **First, register your event.** Register your public event on the Write for Rights website by [signing up on our online form](#). After signing up, you'll receive a confirmation email when your event is up on our event map.
- **Find your event on our event map.** You can click on the unique link in your confirmation email, or [find your event's green pin on the event map](#) and click on it.
- **Click on the Facebook share button when you open your event on the map.** This will connect to Facebook and allow you to directly share your event with all your Facebook friends!



- **Create a Facebook event for your Write for Rights event.** When you create the event on Facebook, be sure to use your event's unique Write-a-thon map link (available in your confirmation email) to advertise your event.



- Urge people who RSVP to your Facebook event to sign up using your event's unique Write-a-thon map link as well. **This is the only way to make your RSVPs and sign-ups count toward our Write for Rights goal!**
