

A Birthday Video for Majid Tavakkoli!

May, 22, 2011 marks Majid Tavakkoli's 25th birthday – one which he will likely spend behind bars. He is one of the hundreds of people who have been jailed in Iran for simply exercising their right to freedom of expression. Majid Tavakkoli was arrested in December 2009 after speaking at a university rally, which took place on National Student Day. The university rally was one of many anti-government protests that followed the disputed presidential election of June 2009. Majid Tavakkoli, a prisoner of conscience, is now serving a term of more than eight years in prison for simply criticizing the government.
