Fun Things To Do Within Walking Distance

Torrey Pines Golf Course (0.5 mi) – Perfect your swing at the world renowned Torrey Pines Golf Course, home to two 18-hole championship courses. This public course has a driving range and is open every day until 30 minutes before dusk. Call our Golf Team at 1-800-991-GOLF (4653) to book your tee time.

Torrey Pines State Natural Reserve (0.8 mi) – Hike a trail in this beautiful 2,000-acre coastal state park overlooking the Pacific Ocean. Some trails lead directly to Torrey Pines State Beach. Trail maps available at our Concierge Desk.

Torrey Pines Gliderport (1.5 mi) – Visit North America's top paragliding and hang gliding location and try an instructional tandem flight. Please call ahead since all flights are dependent on the wind conditions - (858) 452-9858.

Fun Things To Do Just a Short Drive Away

La Jolla Playhouse (2 mi) – A not-for-profit, professional theatre at the University of California San Diego. See Concierge for current showings.

Birch Aquarium (3 mi) – Experience stunning sea life at Birch Aquarium at Scripps Institute of Oceanography. Brochure with \$3.00 off voucher available at our Concierge Desk.

Westfield UTC Mall (4 mi) – Recently expanded and renovated outdoor shopping center with approximately 190 shops, restaurants and a movie theater. See our Concierge for a Mall Directory.

Del Mar Beaches and Village (4 mi) – A quaint seaside village offering unique shops, restaurants and pristine beaches. North Beach or "Dog Beach" is located north of 29th Street and stretches nearly one half mile.

La Jolla Shores (4 mi) – A mile-long crescent of prime sand beach favored by active beachgoers of all interests. Anchored by the *Scripps Institute of Oceanography pier*, this swimming area is popular among families and surfers alike. Shielded by La Jolla Bay, it is also used as a launching ground for snorkeling and kayaking. Brochures available at our Concierge Desk.

Village of La Jolla/Downtown La Jolla (5 mi) -Discover a collection of boutiques, art galleries, "local" dining and more.

La Jolla Cove (5 mi) - A small deep-water bay, flanked by sea caves accessible to adventurers in kayaks and on foot, depending on the tides. The beach itself is small, but it is usually tame waters are popular with swimmers and snorkelers.

The Children's Pool (6 mi) – Located within walking distance from La Jolla Cove. It was originally built as a safe swimming area for children but was claimed long ago by seals and sea lions who beach themselves on the sand. Although now closed for swimming, it offers a crowd-pleasing and often amusing view of these loveable marine inhabitants.

Mt. Soledad (6 mi) - National Veterans Memorial with 360° panoramic views of San Diego and the Pacific Ocean.

Del Mar Fairgrounds (6 mi) – Home to the world-famous San Diego County Fair, KAABOO Del Mar music festival and world-class thoroughbred horse racing (two racing seasons: 7/18/18 – 9/3/18 and 11/9/18 – 12/2/18).

SeaWorld (12 mi) – Soar, splash and play the day away at SeaWorld and delight in the activity and adventure with exciting shows, thrilling rides and unforgettable animal encounters.

Little Italy (15 mi) - A chic, foodie-friendly neighborhood, full of trendy cocktail bars, brewpubs and restaurants.

USS Midway Museum (15 mi) – Go to sea without leaving the port and explore nearly 10 acres of exhibits and displays with more than 30 restored aircraft. Located in downtown San Diego. Brochures available at our Concierge Desk.

San Diego Bay Cruise (15 mi) – A fun option to learn about San Diego's waterfront is a one or two-hour narrated tour of San Diego Bay to see all of the best nautical sights our city has to offer. Discount tour vouchers available at our Concierge Desk.

Balboa Park (16 mi) - Home to 16+ museums, multiple performing arts venues, IMAX Dome, San Diego Zoo and more.

San Diego Zoo (16 mi) – Walk or ride a double-decker bus throughout the expansive park, home to over 4,000 rare and exotic animals exhibited in beautiful garden habitats along with entertaining shows and exhibits. \$5.00 off vouchers available at our Concierge Desk.

Historic Gaslamp Quarter (16 mi) - Lively downtown neighborhood, known for its popular nightlife, bars and restaurants.

LEGOLAND (22 mi) – If you are visiting with children, this is a must-see destination. With more than 50 family rides and "hands-on" attractions and shows, this 128-acre park provides education, adventure and fun for kids ages 2-12.

San Diego Zoo Safari Park (28 mi) – Come along and ride the Journey into Africa at San Diego Safari Park in Escondido.
