# OUR BODIES, OUR STORIES

In this interactive lesson, students have the opportunity to *read abortion stories and engage in conversation around access, reproductive rights, and the humanization* of the individuals behind these stories.

## HOW TO RUN THIS LESSON:

- Print out **ABORTION STORIES** and tape them around the classroom/space.
- Allow students to go on a gallery walk around the classroom/space and read each abortion story.
- Stop students at each abortion story and have them engage in conversation with their peers using the following guiding questions:
  - What feelings, sensations, lived experiences, thoughts, etc. come up for you as you read this abortion story?
  - Why is storytelling a powerful tool to use when defending access to abortion?
  - What role does intersectionality play when it comes to accessing abortion?
  - Why is abortion access a human right?
- Bring students back together as a whole community and encourage them to share what they discussed in small groups, what they learned, and/or what they are taking away from this activity.
