

CONGRESS: PASS THE TRANSGENDER BILL OF RIGHTS

Act Now: Trans Rights are Human Rights

Trans rights are human rights. Period.

Yet attacks against transgender people have only intensified in the last two years. The Trump administration has blocked gender-affirming care, research and education related to transgender people; it has directed law enforcement to investigate the transgender advocacy groups; it has created restrictions on passports for transgender people, and more. At the same time, the government and often the President himself, has promoted anti-transgender rhetoric and misinformation, often to dehumanize and scapegoat transgender people. The scapegoating and violent rhetoric incited by this administration against transgender and nonbinary communities -who already face a heightened risk of violence, homelessness, and poverty- are terrifying and heartbreaking.

Now more than ever, we need legislation that PROTECTS—not attacks—the rights of transgender people.

The Transgender Bill of Rights would provide protections for transgender and nonbinary people by:

- Ensure transgender and nonbinary people have equal access to services and public accommodations
- Recognize the right to bodily autonomy and ethical healthcare
- Promote the safety of trans and nonbinary people
- Enforce the civil rights of transgender people.

The time is now: Urge your Senators and Representative today to pass the Transgender Bill of Rights (H.Res.1058), a resolution that provides a comprehensive framework for protecting the rights of transgender and nonbinary people in our country.
